Regular Board Meeting

March 6, 2012

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Manthei. Trustees present: Engel, Iverson, Koelbl, Leicht, Schumacher, and Wehrs. Also present: Police Chief Charles Ashbeck, County Board Supervisor Ray Ebert, and Village Administrator Teresa Schnitzler.

Public Comment

County Board Supervisor Ray Ebert informed the Board he has been gathering information regarding a dog park proposed to be located on La Crosse County property at East Garland Street extended. The property was formerly the West Salem Rod & Gun Club's deer pen, and the area is approximately 150' X 180' in size. Mr. Ebert talked with La Crosse County Facilities Director James Speropulos. Mr. Speropulos is in favor of moving forward with a lease agreement between La Crosse County and the Village of West Salem as long as La Crosse County is not financially responsible for the park. The area is fenced on three sides, and Mr. Ebert felt the major expenses involved in developing a dog park would be fencing and parking lot improvement. The fence is owned by the West Salem Rod & Gun Club, and Mr. Speropulos has agreed to leave the fencing in place. The Village Board agreed to refer this matter to the Buildings and Grounds Committee.
