Adopt 2009 Operating Plan

Motion by Trustee Hoffman, seconded by Trustee Engel to approve the 2009 Operating Plan, which calls for total expenditures of \$2,187,353 and a levy of \$994,791. Roll call vote: Hanson – nay; remainder of Board – aye. Motion approved.

Subdivision Design

Trustee Hanson discussed stormwater designs for new and old subdivisions. West Rhyme Addition includes sways and infiltration areas, and recently contractors have changed the design of the originally approved stormwater plans. Trustee Hanson stressed the Planning Commission and Village Board should have ultimate decision-making authority on any stormwater management plans.

West Salem Area Tourism Ad Hoc Committee

During the November 18, 2008, West Salem Area Tourism Ad Hoc Committee, Patsy Hofer updated the Committee on the Octagon/Tourism House. The Committee is looking into helping the Historical Society with signage for the house and West Salem Tourist Information. Waiting on bids for the signs. This Committee will keep the Rustic Road Information box filled throughout the year. Steve Plenge will handle this. Greg Mader informed the Committee about the Village Web Site. The Committee will look into ways to update and add to the Web Site for Tourism Information. Adding Tourist Attractions and their Links is step one. The Committee will gather information regarding the Welcome to West Salem signs entering the Village. The Committee will look into Information Booths or kiosks to have located at various key points.
